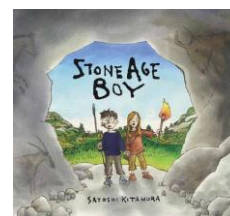

Welcome to Year 3!

It is fantastic to see everyone again after the summer break. The following information gives an outline of our planned work for the Autumn 1 term as well as information regarding your child's homework routine.

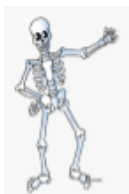
English

Writing - The children will be exploring and learning to write diary entries, instructions and poetry based on the stimulus of the text: Stone Age Boy.



Reading – We expect children to read daily at home and at school. Children will take part in whole class and group reading sessions. We will visit the school library weekly and children will have opportunities to take a reading test linked to their book of choice, which will help us to ensure and monitor progress.

Maths - The children will be focusing on place value and partitioning numbers to help solve addition and subtraction using a range of written methods.



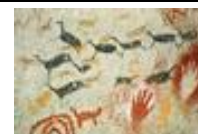
Science - This term we will be investigating 'Animals Including Humans'. The children will compare and contrast the diets of different animals, classify and group animals in different ways and research different food groups to create a healthy meal.

Computing - The children will be following the 'Purple Mash' scheme of work and learning about Internet safety. The children will use computing lessons to research other areas of the curriculum too.



Humanities - This term we will be studying The Stone Age to the Iron Age. We look at the different periods and how they changed over time

Art & D.T - We will be developing our sketching techniques using charcoal and using cave paintings as stimuli. We will also study pointillism.



PSHE - We use the Jigsaw programme to learn about 'Being Me in my World'.

R.E. - Children will be learning about different religious signs and symbols.



PE - Children will need to wear their PE kit to school on the days they have PE. Lessons will take place outside, weather permitting. PE sessions will be taught by PE specialists and class teachers.

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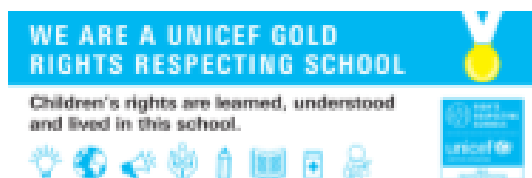
French - The children will have French lessons once a week. They will learn basic vocabulary linked to 'greetings' and learn more about the country and culture of France.

Music – Music lessons are taught by specialist musicians from Merton Music Foundation. In Year 3, the children will learn how to play the violin!

Homework:

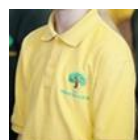
Maths & Spellings homework will be sent home via homework books on a **Friday** and will need to be completed by the following **Thursday**. Please ensure that homework is returned on time.
